Patient Care Orders GSICU: Daily Rounds and Goals Physician Orders (Draft Trial)

E. G. King Critical Care Trauma Unit. DO NOT THIN FROM CHART To be used for Daily Rounds by Critical Care Team.

2. Medication orders must include drug, dose, route, frequency and, if applicable, duration.

3. If medication order is STAT or URGENT, notify RN and place a large X in the STAT/URGENT box at right.

Items include: Head of bed elevated to 30° or Greater, Review Deep Vein Thrombosis (DVT) Prophylaxis, Review of Gastric Ulcer Prophylaxis, Daily Sedation Vacation with delirium assessment, Ventilator Weaning & Daily Spontaneous Breathing Trials, Review frequency of Lab investigations and CXR, Chest x-ray AP upright tomorrow am., Review of Central Venous and Arterial Lines (site/need?), Medication Reconciliation, Antibiotic review, Soft restraints to extremities, Patient assessed for mobilization, Eligible for/enrolled into research study? (call 780-407-7448): ABLE, SPARK, REALISTIC 80, OSCILLATE, SAPPHIRE, TOP UP, ACUTE LIVER FAILURE, STARRT-AKI, EUPHRATES.

Items include: Fluid Management Goal (Neutral balance, Negative, Active resuscitation), Hemodynamic Goals (MAP, CVP, BP systolic, CvS02), Urine output goal (30-100ml/hour, other), Continue Electrolyte replenishment protocols, Social Work consultation, Review of enteral feeds/nutritional support/nutritional goals, Occupational Therapy assessment, Drug allergies reviewed, Family Update/Conference, Goals of Care reviewed and documented.
